The **Church Office** is open Tuesday - Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and the **Church** itself is open daily (except Mon.), 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., for prayer and visitation.

Holy Communion is celebrated each Sunday at 9:00 a.m. and on Wednesdays there is an informal Eucharist, light lunch and Christian teaching at 12:15 The details for the **SUNDAY 10:30 a.m.** services are listed above.

Informal Prayer takes place in the Assistant's Office from 10:10 to 10:15 a.m. every Sunday prior to worship. Everyone is welcome to join in this opportunity for prayer in preparation for our worship at 10:30 a.m.

Church School information:

Church School (ages 5 to 10), and **Youth Group** (Grade 6 and up) are held every week, except when there is a Family Eucharist. (**There will be no Church School on March 1 & 8, due to school break.**) The Church School and Youth Group begin their worship in the church at 10:30 a.m. and then after the Children's Ministry go into the Church hall.
