**ASH WEDNESDAY, February 18:** - **Holy Communion with Imposition of Ashes** will be held in the Church at 12:15 p.m. and at 5:30 p.m. Join us for a meaningful beginning to Lent at the Ash Wednesday services. The imposition of ashes is a sign of our penitence for the collective sins of the world and of our community. The ashes are a reminder of our mortality and of the gracious gift of life offered to us by God through Jesus.

**LENTEN LEARNING SERIES – Sundays during Lent, starting February 22, following the 10:30 a.m. service:** The theme this year will be TIME. We will be looking at different ways time can be considered sacred in our lives and what we can do to treat it as such. The Lenten Study this year will be based on that of the brothers of the Society of St. John the Evangelist (SSJE), an Anglican religious order.
